21	SECTION 1. Ark	cansas Code § 5-16-101(b), concerning	the offense of
22	video voyeurism, is amended to read as follows:

2	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 5-16-102(b), concerning the offense of		
3	voyeurism, is amended to read as follows:		
4	(b) A person commits the offense of voyeurism if for the purpose of		
5	sexual arousal or gratification, he or she knowingly:		
6	(1) Without the consent of each person who is present in the		
7	private place, personally or through the use of an unmanned vehicle or		
8	aircraft, looks into a private place that is, or is part of, a public		
9	accommodation and in which a person may reasonably be expected to be nude or		
10	partially nude; or		
11	(2) Enters personally or through the use of an unmanned vehicle		
12	or aircraft another person's private property without the other person's		
13	consent and looks into any person's dwelling unit if all of the following		
14	apply:		
15	(A) The person looks into the dwelling with the intent		
16	purpose to intrude upon or interfere with a person's privacy;		
17	(B) The person looks into a part of the dwelling in which		
18	an individual is present;		
19	(C) The individual present has a reasonable expectation of		
20	privacy in that part of the dwelling; and		
21	(D) The individual present does not consent to the		
22	person's looking into that part of the dwelling.
