SENATE BILL NO. 2022 (As Sent to Governor)

- 1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 97-29-61, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO PROHIBIT "PEEPING TOM" ACTIVITIES THAT DO NOT AMOUNT TO FELONIOUS TRESPASS; TO AMEND SECTION 97-29-63, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROHIBIT SURREPTITIOUS PHOTOGRAPHY OF A PERSON'S BODY OR 5 UNDERCLOTHING UNDER CIRCUMSTANCES IN WHICH A PERSON WOULD 6 REASONABLY EXPECT TO NOT BE THE SUBJECT OF SUCH PHOTOGRAPHY; AND 7 FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 9 **SECTION 1.** Section 97-29-61, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 10 amended as follows:
- 11 97-29-61. (1) (a) Any person who enters upon real
- property, whether the original entry is legal or not, and 12
- 13 thereafter pries or peeps through a window or other opening in a
- 14 dwelling or other building structure for the lewd, licentious and
- 15 indecent purpose of spying upon the occupants thereof, shall be
- 16 quilty of a felonious trespass * * *.
- 17 (b) Any person who looks through a window, hole or
- 18 opening, or otherwise views by means of any instrumentality,
- including, but not limited to, a periscope, telescope, binoculars, 19
- 20 drones, camera, motion-picture camera, camcorder or mobile phone,

- 21 into the interior of a bedroom, bathroom, changing room, fitting
- 22 room, dressing room, spa, massage room or therapy room or tanning
- 23 booth, or the interior of any other area in which the occupant has
- a reasonable expectation of privacy, with the intent to invade the 24
- 25 privacy of a person or persons inside and without the consent or
- 26 knowledge of every person present, for the lewd, licentious and
- indecent purpose of spying upon the occupant or occupants thereof, 27
- 28 shall be guilty of a felony.
- 29 (2) (a) Except as provided in paragraph (b) of this
- 30 subsection, a person who was over the age of twenty-one (21) at
- the time of the offense who is convicted of a violation of 31
- 32 subsection (1) of this section shall be imprisoned in the custody
- 33 of the Department of Corrections not more than five (5) years.
- 34 (* * *b) When one or more occupants spied upon is a
- child under sixteen (16) years of age, a person who * * * was over 35
- 36 the age of twenty-one (21) at the time of the offense who is
- 37 convicted of a violation of subsection (1) of this section * * *
- shall be imprisoned in the custody of the Department of 38
- 39 Corrections not more than ten (10) years.
- 40 SECTION 2. Section 97-29-63, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 41 amended as follows:
- 42 97-29-63. (1) (a) It is a felony for any person * * with
- lewd, licentious or indecent intent * * * to photograph, film, 43
- videotape, record or otherwise reproduces the image of another 44
- person without the permission of * * * <u>the</u> other person when * * * 45

- 46 <u>the other</u> person is located in a place where a person would intend
- 47 to be in a state of undress and have a reasonable expectation of
- 48 privacy, including, but not limited to, private dwellings or any
- 49 facility, public or private, used as a restroom, bathroom, shower
- 50 room, tanning booth, locker room, fitting room, dressing room or
- 51 bedroom shall be guilty of a felony * * *.
- 52 (b) It is a felony for any person to invade the privacy
- of another person and with lewd, licentious or indecent intent to
- 54 photograph, film, videotape, record or otherwise reproduce the
- 55 image of another, identifiable person under or through the
- 56 clothing being worn by that other person for the purpose of
- 57 viewing the body of, or the undergarments worn by, the other
- 58 person without the consent or knowledge of the other person and
- 59 under circumstances in which the other person has a reasonable
- 60 expectation that the other person's body or undergarments would
- 61 not be viewed or would not be the subject of a reproduced image.
- 62 (2) (a) Except as provided in paragraph (b) of this
- 63 subsection, a person who was over the age of twenty-one (21) at
- 64 the time of the offense who is convicted of a violation of
- 65 subsection (1) of this section shall be punished by a fine of Five
- 66 Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) or by imprisonment of not more than
- 67 five (5) years in the custody of the Department of Corrections, or
- 68 both.
- 69 (* * *b) Where the person who is secretly
- 70 photographed, filmed, videotaped or otherwise reproduced is a

- 71 child under sixteen (16) years of age, a person * * * who was over
- 72 the age of twenty-one (21) at the time of the offense who is
- 73 convicted of a violation of subsection (1) of this section * * *
- 74 shall be punished by a fine of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00)
- 75 or by imprisonment of not more than ten (10) years in the custody
- 76 of the Department of Corrections, or both.
- 77 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 78 and after July 1, 2015.
