

CHAPTER 109A: - OPERATION OF DRONES

§ 109A.01 - DEFINITIONS.

For purposes of this chapter, the following definitions shall apply:

DRONE: An unmanned aircraft and all of the associated support equipment, control station, data links, telemetry, communications and navigation equipment, etc., necessary to operate the unmanned aircraft.

RIGHT-OF-WAY: The land, or interest therein, acquired for or devoted to a street, highway, or other public thoroughfare.

SPECIAL EVENT: Any public gathering or event held outdoors on village property that requires the issuance of a permit from the village.

VILLAGE: The Village of Schaumburg.

VILLAGE PROPERTY: Any real property owned by the Village of Schaumburg.

§ 109A.02 - OPERATION OF DRONES PROHIBITED.

The operation of a drone within one hundred (100) feet of the perimeter of any village property or on any village right-of-way during a special event is hereby prohibited.

§ 109A.03 - EXCEPTIONS.

The prohibitions contained in section 109A.02 shall not apply to any drone operated by or on behalf of the village for purposes of monitoring or documenting any special event.
